### NEED A "WEEK" IDEA FOR THE SUMMER FOR KIDS?

The Oratory Religion Camp is being held July 12<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> or July 19<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>. This camp is for children 6-12 yrs old and is at a low cost of \$125.00 for the week. This includes food, room, and all activities and snacks. We have religion in the morning and then in the afternoon we have sports, arts and crafts and swimming with a certified lifeguard. We serve three meals a day along with an afternoon snack.
