Next weekend, January 24-25, Our Lady of the Hills will be conducting a postcard campaign against the Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA). This is part of a nationwide effort which is recommended by the Conference of US Catholic Bishops (USCCB). The

FOCA is a radical piece of legislation that would abolish all restrictions on abortion, including parental notification laws. It would enshrine abortion as a "fundamental right" (a status it does not have right now), making it mandatory to include abortion in any Federal health benefits. It would even abolish conscience clauses that make it possible for hospitals and medical personnel to opt out of performing or referring for abortion. President-elect Obama has pledged to sign FOCA if it is passed by Congress, so it is imperative to let our Senators and Representatives know that we want them to oppose it. For more information, see: <http://www.usccb.org/prolife/issues/FOCA/> In particular, the link "Legal Analysis" gives a carefully reasoned argument as to why FOCA would have such a sweeping effect on abortion.
