### The Second Step to the RCIA: The Catechumenate Phase

Who should attend RCIA? Those interested in joining the Church, those who were baptized in the Church but have not received all of the Sacraments, and those wishing to know their faith. All are welcome.



The RCIA journey begins with the Inquiry Phase. The Inquiry Phase covers an explanation of the Mass, the Bible, Sin and Grace, and the Sacraments. At the beginning of August the second phase or Catechumenate phase begins. However, it's never too late to start! In the Catechumenate phase the beliefs of the Church are studied. Key issues covered include Sacred Scripture, Liturgy, Faith, Prayer, The Church, Church History and many other topics. Included in these topics are Mary and the Saints, the Pope, and why the Eucharist--the Body and Blood of Christ--is central to our Faith. The time spent in this period will vary from person to person. This is a time of questioning, study, and reflection. Although the RCIA process proceeds with a set schedule, each participant proceeds at their own pace. There will never be any pressure.

RCIA Classes are held at 10 AM in the Library in the Family Life Center.

The dates for the rest of the 2009 Inquiry Phase of RCIA are July 26. The Rite of Welcome is scheduled for August 2<sup>nd</sup>.
